


8 DAYS SPAIN BY PROVINCE TOUR CADIZ

A snapshot of the EuroTourGuide 8-day Coach Tour to discover the Province of Cádiz. The day-by-day itinerary will be emailed to you upon request for the final payment.

THE JOURNEYS

We depart early on the first day, allowing everyone to relax and nap as we cover the kilometres from the local area. Regular stops will be made every 90 to 120 minutes, with a longer break for lunch. Our aim is to arrive at the first hotel in the late afternoon. We will depart mid-morning for the return journey, giving you time for a walk before leaving the hotel. We'll make regular comfort breaks and aim to arrive back in the early evening.

THE HOTELS

We stay in 3 different hotels to keep daily travel distances to a minimum.

Hotel 1 is our base for the first 3 nights. This 4-star hotel has a Google rating of 4.3 and a Booking.com rating of 8.3. It is located just 550 meters from the beach, within a flat walk, and a few minutes from a bustling plaza filled with tapas bars. Breakfast is a hot and cold buffet, and the evening meal is also included, offering a choice of 2 starters, 2 mains, plus dessert, along with water and a glass of wine.

We stay the next 2 nights in **Hotel 2**, a 3-star hotel owned by two brothers, with a Google rating of 4.4 and a Booking.com rating of 8.4. It is situated just a few meters from a beachfront promenade, from where the small town of 22,000 inhabitants extends behind it. Breakfast is a cold continental buffet style, and the evening meal is not included. There are plenty of dining options on the promenade, and a Mercadona supermarket is just 300 meters away.

The final 2 nights are spent in the charming and tranquil inland **Hotel 3**, a 2-star establishment with a Google rating of 4.3 and a Booking.com rating of 8.7. It is located at the entrance to the village, just a short walk from the river, whose inhabitants give the hotel its name. The village is an uphill walk and features some lovely little bars for its 2,000 residents. Both breakfast and evening meals (water and a glass of water) are included.









TOUR INFORMATION....

Cádiz is the southernmost part of mainland Spain and the southernmost part of continental Europe. Covering an area of 7,385 square kilometres (2,851 sq mi), the entire province has a population of 1,245,960. Unlike the arid Almería province further east in Andalusia, the Cádiz region is much wetter and therefore much greener. The main industry is tourism, and the province is also famous for its Sherry. Cádiz boasts many kilometres of beautiful beaches, and its southernmost tip has become Europe's leading kitesurfing destination due to unique wind conditions. The Sierra de Cádiz comarca is popularly known as the "Pueblos Blancos" which are picturesque whitewashed villages nestled between mountain peaks that rise up to 1,600 metres.

CITIES

We spend almost a full day in the capital of the province, Cádiz, which is also Europe's oldest continuously inhabited city, with a history spanning an incredible 3,500 years. A wonderful path encircles the edge of this peninsula, and connects onto the Paseo Fernando Quiñones causeway to the San Sebastián Castle. Discover the Botanical Park, home to trees and plants from all over the world, brought to Cádiz when it was a thriving port city. Wander through the narrow, flat streets of the old quarter, visit the Cathedral, and soak up the atmosphere of this unique, compact city.











We visit the province's second-largest city and the cradle of Sherry production: Jerez de la Frontera. Here, you will have free time for lunch and the opportunity to wander around the city in the afternoon, admiring the architecture and the numerous old wine barrels placed throughout the streets.











Another major urban area we explore is the town of Tarifa, a paradise for kitesurfers. It features a 2-metre-wide causeway that separates the Mediterranean Sea from the Atlantic Ocean—a must-see photo opportunity! The narrow streets of the old town are a delight to wander through, and the relaxed, bohemian surfer atmosphere adds to its charm.









VILLAGES

We visit another 8 small towns and villages, each with its own unique character. These include a once-busy tuna fishing colony; a village famous for its massive 30-metre-high and 200-metre-wide sand dune, where cows are allowed to roam freely on the sand; a seaside village where clever, seasick, or perhaps just lazy fishermen built walls in the sea to catch fish brought in by the tide; and three of the "Pueblos Blancos" villages nestled in the Sierra de Cádiz, each renowned for their artisan products.
