DAY 1 TUESDAY 3RD MARCH 2026

Our adventure begins with the journey to the fascinating Granada Geopark. The location where Europe's first nomadic people chose to settle - a treasure trove of history and a box full of scenic delights including the badlands, rivers and mountains, topped off with the beautifully delicate blossom of the cultivated almond trees.

On arrival, we enjoy a delicious menu del día (included), the perfect way to sample authentic local flavours before our afternoon discovery. We then visit the delightful Ethnographic Museum (included), where the stories of everyday life in the region come alive. Located in a cave it offers a glimpse into a slower, simpler way of life of the locals. One of the highlights is joining a hands-on bread-making class, where you can roll up your sleeves and learn how to bake the region's traditional artisan bread – a real taste of the past.

Later, we settle into our welcoming hotel, with time to relax and unwind. As evening falls, we gather together for a leisurely dinner, complete with wine and water, rounding off a wonderful first day in true Andalusian style.











DAY 2 WEDNESDAY 4TH MARCH 2026

After atypical Spanish style breakfast we head out for the day in north west area of the Geopark.

Our first stop is the glittering blue reservoir, where we pause at the viewpoint to soak up the sweeping panoramas before enjoying a gentle stroll along the top of the dam. Arriving in time for Coffee in a picturesque town, we wander the historic streets complete with white washed houses. The adventurous can climb the 279 steps to the castle for amazing views. We take a short drive to the picnic area where the famous walk beside the River begins (included). This flat 3km walk incorporates wooden hanging platforms, a cave and a metal suspension bridge – as the path is there and back, you can walk as much or as little as you please. After working up an appetite, we travel on to a village famed for its seven-towered castle and elegant noble houses. We indulge in a delicious menu de dia (included) and then have a tour of the castle (included). The day finishes with the evening meal in the hotel.











DAY 3 THURSDAY 5TH MARCH 2026

Today we set off to discover the wild beauty of the Spanish badlands! Our adventure begins in a quiet village, where history comes alive at the Megalithic Interpretation Centre (included). Here, modern technology brings to life what daily existence was like over 5,000 years ago, with fascinating insights into the 198 dolmens that still surround the town. From the past we move into the dramatic present, climbing aboard chauffeur-driven 4x4s (included) to journey deep into the extraordinary desert. This surreal landscape of ravines, canyons, and towering "fairy chimneys" feels almost otherworldly, and as we travel off the beaten track, we come face to face with its raw beauty—an unforgettable experience that shows nature at its most spectacular. After soaking in these incredible sights, we return to our coach and enjoy a hearty menu del día lunch (included), freshly prepared and full of local flavour. In the afternoon, we step into a different way of life with a visit to Paco's remarkable cave house and museum. It is a real privilege to be welcomed into his home, as he shares the traditions and stories of the troglodyte lifestyle, before guiding us through the upper floors, which he and his neighbours have lovingly transformed into a museum. We round the day off with the evening meal.












DAY 4 THURSDAY 5TH MARCH 2026

Our last day starts with the Spanish style breakfast before we head to the southern end of the Geopark on our route home.

There is time for a coffee in a tiny village before we catch the tourist train to discover one of the caves where our prehistoric ancestors once lived (included). Models bring their daily lives into context and the marvel of the geology of the caves provides an ideal setting – there are no steps just gentle ramps to navigate. From here, we continue to a nearby complex, home to an animal rescue centre. A highlight of the visit is a captivating bird of prey show, where these magnificent creatures soar gracefully overhead. Afterwards, we share our final meal together (included), a fitting moment to reflect on the discoveries and memories of our journey.

We take a comfort stop on the way home and aim to arrive back locally at approximately 19:00.
