DAY 1 THURSDAY 11TH JUNE 2026

We begin our day with a relaxed local departure at 09:15, easing into the journey with a refreshing coffee stop beside a serene bay. It's the perfect moment to breathe in the fresh sea air, soak up the peaceful surroundings, and enjoy a gentle start to the day.

Our route then takes us directly to the southernmost tip of the natural park, where we arrive at the picturesque village that lends its name to this stunning landscape. With its whitewashed charm and sweeping sea views, it offers a wealth of welcoming promenade restaurants—ideal for a leisurely lunch while watching the sunlight dance on the Mediterranean.

In the afternoon, we embark on our first scenic drive into the heart of the park, winding through dramatic coastal landscapes and striking natural beauty. This picturesque route leads us to an impressive clifftop lighthouse, where unforgettable views stretch across the horizon.

Our journey continues as we skirt around the edge of the park, arriving in the coastal town of Carboneras at approximately 17:30. There will be time to stroll along the elegant promenade, paddle in the clear waters, or simply unwind on the soft sandy beach before enjoying a delicious, freshly prepared evening meal at 20:30—served in banquet style for a memorable end to the day.



DAY 2 FRIDAY 12TH JUNE 2026

After a Spanish-style breakfast we set off on an exceptional day out. We head straight into the heart of the Cabo de Gata Natural Park, a place of raw, untouched beauty that feels a world away from the modern world. Think wide-open beaches, rugged volcanic cliffs, and quiet whitewashed villages that haven't changed in decades.

Our journey takes us to a historic seaside castle used in the filming of Game of Thrones—a perfect photo opportunity and a chance to walk where Hollywood has walked! We weave through picturesque fishing hamlets and stop for morning coffee in a charming coastal spot, before enjoying a delicious Menu del Día at a seafront restaurant—local flavours served with sweeping sea views.

In the afternoon we return to the hotel around 16:00, with plenty of time to put your feet up, enjoy the beach, or sip something cool on the terrace before another sociable evening and a well-earned dinner.



DAY 3 SATURDAY 13TH JUNE 2026

This is the highlight of the festivities, so you can choose to spend the morning in the town witnessing the thrilling Moors and Christians battle - a true spectacle of history and tradition. Or you can take a short drive to the legendary hilltop village of Mojácar for a stroll through its iconic winding streets. As the celebrations pause for siesta, we do the same, enjoying a leisurely menú del día at the hotel. But the excitement picks up again in the evening with the grand Moors and Christians Parade, passing right by our hotel. To keep our energy up and ensure we don't miss a second, we grab bocadillos (filled rolls) and fully immerse ourselves in the electric atmosphere. The day is topped off with a nocturnal firework display at 00:30.



DAY 4 SUNDAY 14TH JUNE 2026

After last night's festivities, we enjoy a leisurely late breakfast before setting off up the coast to the charming resort of MazarrónAguilas for more sun, sea, and relaxation! Here, you can take a scenic stroll along the promenade and choose from the beach front restaurants for a light lunch. With weekend beachgoers adding to the lively atmosphere, it's the perfect spot to soak up the coastal vibe. We plan to arrive back at La Zenia at approximately 16:15.



2* HALF BOARD HOTEL TIO FELIPE CARBONERAS

The family feel Hotel Felipe is perfectly situated in beautiful Carboneras. Carboneras is a lovely little all year round coastal town with approximately 6,000 inhabitants. It has a number of small shops and lots of beaches! The hotel is located just 150 meters from the castle, where the coach can unload and 250 meters from the bar lined beach front promenade.

The hotel has a cafe, where the Spanish style breakfasts will be served and a restaurant, where the menu del noche will be taken. The hotel has an elevator, free wifi and all of the rooms have private bathrooms with a shower over the bath and air-conditioning.

Hotel Tio Felipe has a Booking.com rating of 7.7 Good and a Tripadvisor rating of 3.6. Here are some of the reviews

"Nice, centrally located hotel. The male receptionist was very attentive, friendly and accommodating. Would definitely stay again"

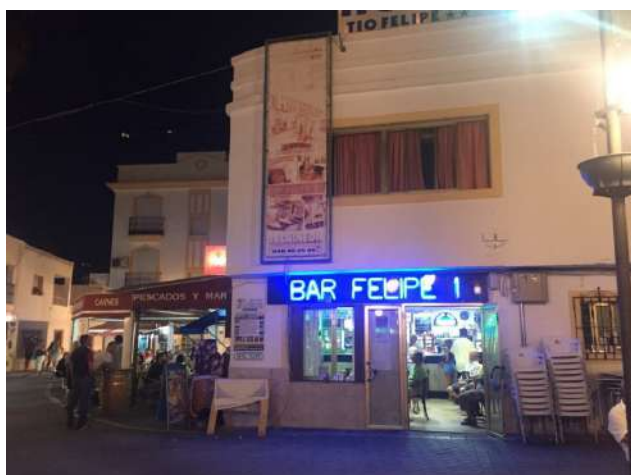

Breakfast, which is taken in the cafe beside the hotel, includes coffee or infusion, juice and a toastado or croissant. Dinner is a 3 course meal with bread and table salad. Both the first and second courses will be chosen from the nightly menu. 1 glass of house wine, beer, soft drink or water is included. Please see the sample menu below

The restaurant, which is also owned by the same family, has a google rating of 3.4. This is not because of it's service or food, but because people are charged more than they think they should be. Your evening meal and first drink (1 glass of water, soft drink, beer or house wine) is included in the cost of this tour. All other drinks must be paid for, so please check the price when ordering.
