DAY 1 TUESDAY 15TH SEPTEMBER 2026

Get ready for a day full of discoveries! We set off early at 07:00am, with two comfortable breaks along the way, before reaching the enchanting town of Teruel — a true showcase of classic Mudéjar beauty. Here there is some free time to grab a delicious bite and have a wander to admire some of Teruel's most iconic sights — from its famous mudéjar adorned towers and the cathedral's colorful polychrome roof to the Torico statue and the Tomb of the Lovers. Afterwards, we continue our journey to Zaragoza, arriving at our hotel around 16:45, ready to relax and look forward to more adventures!



DAY 2 WEDNESDAY 16TH SEPTEMBER 2026

Enjoy a full day to discover Zaragoza at your own pace — a city rich in history, art, and stunning architecture! Begin with the magnificent Basílica del Pilar, an iconic symbol of Zaragoza with its grand façade, eleven domes, and soaring towers. For unforgettable views across the city and the River Ebro, take the lift to the top of one of the towers. Just opposite stands the beautiful Cathedral of San Salvador (La Seo), where you can admire the intricate Mudéjar wall, a dazzling Main Altarpiece, and visit the impressive Tapestry Museum. Step back in time at the Municipal Museums, where the Roman Forum, ancient Theatre, River Port, and Thermal Baths reveal Zaragoza's rich Roman heritage. Don't miss the Lonja with its exquisite fan-vaulted ceiling or the elegant Pablo Gargallo Museum dedicated to one of Spain's great sculptors. Art lovers will be drawn to the Goya Museum, home to a stunning collection of works by Aragón's most celebrated artist, and history comes alive at the enchanting Aljafería Palace, with its Islamic, Mudéjar, and Renaissance styles. For something unique, the Origami Museum offers a fascinating glimpse into the delicate art of paper folding, while the IAACC Pablo Serrano showcases contemporary sculptures and exhibitions. Take time to relax in Zaragoza's beautiful parks, including the lush Luis Buñuel Water Park and the historic Parque Grande José Antonio Labordeta, complete with Botanical Gardens and shaded avenues perfect for a gentle stroll. Or, for a truly memorable experience, visit the spectacular Fresh Water River Aquarium, the largest in Europe, housing an extraordinary range of river species from around the world.



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DAY 3 THURSDAY 17TH SEPTEMBER 2026

In the morning, we set off for Belchite, one of Spain's most haunting and unforgettable historical sites. This ghost village, frozen in time, was devastated during the Spanish Civil War and, by Franco's orders, was left in ruins as a stark reminder of the conflict. On arrival, we'll take a guided tour with an English-speaking expert who will bring the powerful history of Belchite to life. As we walk through the crumbling streets, past shattered churches and abandoned homes, you'll hear the moving stories behind the battle that changed this once-thriving town forever. We have time in the inhabited part of the village for a spot of lunch before returning to Zaragoza, so you can continue to explore this delightful city or simply relax in any of its plazas and soak up the Sunday afternoon atmosphere.



DAY 4 FRIDAY 18TH SEPTEMBER 2026

After breakfast, we travel to the enchanting Monasterio de Piedra, a former Cistercian monastery set in one of Aragón's most beautiful natural landscapes. This unforgettable visit invites you to explore the evocative ruins of the monastery itself, wander through the ancient cloisters, and discover the charming Carriage Room and the fascinating Chocolate Exhibition, where you'll learn about the first chocolate ever brought to Europe. But the real magic lies in the grounds: a 5 km walking route winds through lush parkland along the Piedra River, leading you past spectacular waterfalls, crystal-clear lakes, hidden grottoes, and cool, shaded woodlands. During the return journey we stop in a local restaurant for a Menu del Dia (included), arriving back in Zaragoza later afternoon.



DAY 5 SATURDAY 19TH SEPTEMBER 2026

After breakfast, we begin our leisurely journey home, making a comfortable stop along the way before reaching the charming coastal town of Port Saplaya - often called the "*Venice of Valencia*" for its colourful canals and unique seaside charm. Here, you'll have time to enjoy a delicious lunch at one of the many inviting restaurants, soak up the relaxed atmosphere, and take a gentle stroll along the stunning beachfront promenade, breathing in the fresh sea air.

We then continue our journey, with another comfort stop en route, before arriving back locally at approximately 19:00 - bringing our wonderful trip to a close, filled with memories to treasure.

The elegant 3-star Hotel Inca Boutique is situated right in the heart of the pedestrianised old town, just 150 metres to the famous Cathedral Basílica de Nuestra Señora del Pilar. It has a Booking.com rating of 8.7 and a Google rating of 4.

A buffet style Breakfast is included. The rooms are decorated in a contemporary and inviting style, and all rooms have walk in showers.

Please note that the coach can not access the pedestrianised street, drop off / pick up is 250m away.
