DAY 1 WEDNESDAY 4TH NOVEMBER 2026

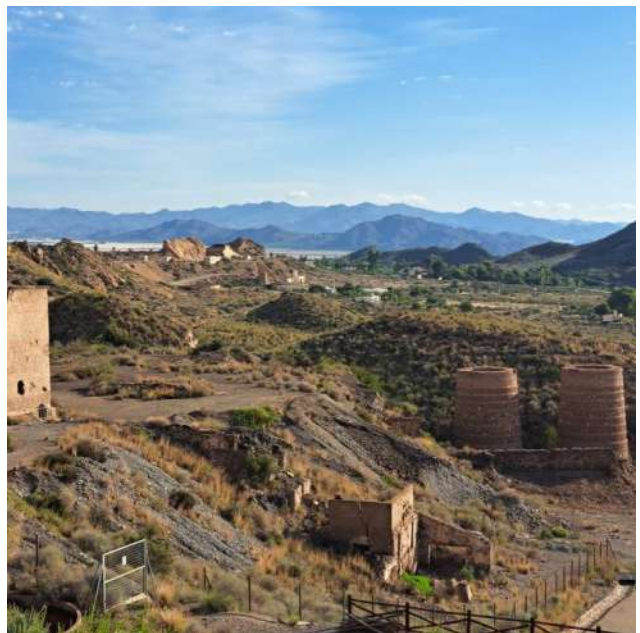
Leaving locally at a leisurely time, we ease straight into holiday mode with a stop at a secluded beach front chiringuito. Here, you can relax with a brunch (not included) or take a stroll along the shoreline to enjoy the sound of the lapping sea. Continuing to the coastal town, we split into two groups to board the little tourist train, which whisks us up the steep, winding road to the hilltop 18th-century castle. Here, you can soak in sweeping 360-degree views of the Mediterranean coastline and countryside. Explore the interpretation centre to discover local historical artefacts, and take your turn to don a virtual reality headset for an immersive visit to the Mina Rica. This virtual tour offers a captivating first glimpse of the glittering Pulpi Geode, giving you the unique sensation of stepping right inside the giant crystal cylinder—an experience that is strictly prohibited in person. After this exciting morning, we check into the hotel with plenty of time to relax and unwind. You might take a walk along the beach front promenade into the centre of town or simply sit back with a drink in the hotel bar before enjoying a buffet evening meal complete with wine and water.



DAY 2 THURSDAY 5TH NOVEMBER 2026

After a delicious buffet breakfast we take a short drive to the Sierras and to the town of Pulpi. Here we have a guided visit of the largest European Collection of Luminescent Minerals, another reminder of nature's wonders! After a quick coffee, we make our way to the Mine to view the Geode. This amazing crystal cavern is encased in a rugby ball shaped cavity of 11 cubic meters which is 8 meters long and 2 meters wide. The finger nail thin 2 meter white gypsum crystals jut out at a jumble of angles from the walls. To view the crystal we peer inside the cave as the guide turns on the light and reveals the geode in all of its splendour. We split into 2 groups, which enter the mine at an interval of 30 minutes. There is a lovely view, picnic tables and benches, snack vending machine, little shop and 1 unisex toilet plus the coach will be open whilst each group is waiting. The visit takes a total of 120 minutes, 90 minutes of which is spent underground. The flat mined passage ways through which we wander, vary in height with some very short sections at 1.5m. We stop at regular intervals in roomy areas as the Guide explains in English all about the mine, gradually introducing us to the amazing range of minerals which characterise this Mina Rica. Then it is time to slowly descend the metal spiral staircase the 60m to the level of the Geode. In order to view the crystal cave you must wear a mask as you lean into the cavern. Once the whole group of 15 have been wowed by this spectacular natural phenomenon it is time to slowly wind our way back up the 160 steps, pausing as much and as long as necessary before wandering back along the tunnel to the brilliant daylight. It is obligatory to wear trainers and only the guide is allowed to take photos, all of which will be sent to you via email. There is one more treat in store! A picnic will be waiting for you at the picnic tables once you exit the mine.





4* SENATOR AGUILAS HOTEL

The Senator Aguilas Hotel is situated opposite Águila's marina and the Mediterranean Sea with direct access to Águila's seafront promenade. The Hotel has a Booking.com rating of 8.2 and a Google rating of 4.1. A buffet style evening meal and a glass of wine or water is included as is the hot buffet breakfast. All bedrooms overlook the countryside, although there is the option to upgrade to a sea view for 20€ per room, this must be requested when paying the deposit. There are a small number of rooms with a walk in shower, all of which have sea views



VISITING THE MINE

- Visiting the Geode in the Mine requires you to have a good level of mobility. You can enter with walking sticks or crutches, but not with walkers, wheelchairs or scooters. You need to be able to remain standing for 90 minutes (there is a bench to wait on near the actual Geode) and to be able to descend and ascend 160 steps in each direction.
- The mine is an enclosed underground space and is therefore not suitable for anyone with claustrophobia, breathing or anxiety issues which can be brought on by being in an enclosed underground environment.
- You must wear trainers to visit the mine and put on a mask when you are peering inside the crystal cave. You are given a hair net and helmet to wear to prevent scratching your head on the roof in some areas of the tunnels. It is a constant 18 degrees in the mine, so light weight clothes are ideal.
- There is the option to enjoy the coach tour without visiting the mine and of course you will be able to have the virtual experience. You will have a two and a half hour stop in the area where the mine tours start. There is a lovely view from here to the sea, picnic tables and benches, a unisex toilet, drink and snack vending machine and the coach will be open for you to use.
- Only the official guide is allowed to take photos, these will be sent to you via email.
- The mine will be closed if an Orange or Red weather alert is issued for rain.
