- 08:00 Leave locally we journey via coach to Madrid with 3 comfort stops. We plan to arrive at the 4* Hotel Praga at approximately 15:00/15:30 for Check In.
- Wednesday afternoon and all day on Thursday and Saturday are yours to really discover and get to know this stunning Capital city.
- On Friday we take a guided tour to the Escorial Palace and the Valley of the Fallen
- There is a public bus stop outside of the Hotel Praga where the No23 stops every 8 to 10 minutes and takes you to the Plaza Mayor in the centre of Madrid. It is a walk of 850 meters to the Marques de Vadillo Metro where the Green Line No 5 takes you to the Metro Stations of Opera and Gran Via

Madrid has so many things to see and do that your time here will be actioned packed. We will give you information on the coach about the places your can visit including

- the Royal Palace, the number 1 attraction
- the Prado, the main Spanish national art museum
- the Retiro Park with it's boating lake, wide tree lined avenues and stunning collection of sculptures
- more than 80 museums including the Reina Sofia Museum, Sorolla Museum, Museum of the Americas, Natural Science Museum, Thyssen-Bornemisza Museum, National Museum of Decorative Arts, Costume Museum, The National Mint Museum, Museum of Romanticism, National Archaeological Museum, Naval Museum, Madrid History Museum, Robot Museum, Geominero Museum, Wax Museum and a whole lot more besides
- the Plaza del Sol, the centre of the country
- the Plaza Mayor with its symmetrical architecture
- the Mercado San Miguel a tapas market in a stunning art nouveau building
- take a tour of the Santiago Bernabeu Stadium
- some 15,000 places to eat and drink

Madrid, the vibrant heart of Spain, is a treasure trove of culture, history, and excitement, here are some day itineraries to get you thinking about all of the wonderful experiences you can enjoy.

Explore the majestic Royal Palace, a masterpiece of Baroque architecture that's brimming with regal charm. Stroll across the Plaza Mayor, a bustling square steeped in history, before heading to Puerta del Sol, the iconic centre of Spain. Visit the lively San Miguel tapas market, a must for all tourists



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Shop till you drop along Gran Vía, Madrid's answer to Broadway, filled with trendy boutiques and cafés. Spend your afternoon exploring Matadero Madrid, a former slaughterhouse turned contemporary cultural hub hosting exhibitions, performances, and film screenings. As evening falls, watch the sunset at Temple of Debod, an ancient Egyptian temple gifted to Spain, before enjoying a Performance at one of Madrid many Theatres.



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Spend time in the lush Retiro Park, where you can row a boat or admire the Crystal Palace. Lose yourself in the Prado Museum, home to world-famous masterpieces by Velázquez, Goya, and El Greco.



Madrid is home to a host of quirky and unique museums that will surprise and delight. The Museo del Traje, Madrid's fascinating Costume Museum. This elegant space explores centuries of fashion history, from traditional Spanish garments like flamenco dresses to haute couture pieces by Balenciaga. Head to the Museo Geominero, a hidden gem tucked away in the Spanish Geological and Mining Institute. This museum dazzles with its vast collection of minerals, gemstones, and fossils displayed under a stunning stained-glass ceiling. Visit the legendary Santiago Bernabéu Stadium and walk through the players' tunnel, sit in the team's dugout and admire countless trophies. Visit to the Wax Museum for an entertaining blend of history and pop culture, where you can meet lifelike figures of Spanish royalty, global celebrities, and fictional icons



Friday 23rd April 2027

We leave the hotel and drop off the Tennis goers at the Caja Magica before taking the motorway to the village of Escorial where there is time for a morning coffee. We embark on our guided tour around this fascinating Palace and Monastery, admiring it's main incredible features. There is free time for you to find a bite to eat in the village before we head to the controversial Valley of the Fallen. Our local guide will keep us spellbound with the secrets and of these two monumental locations. We will return to the hotel for approximately 17:30.





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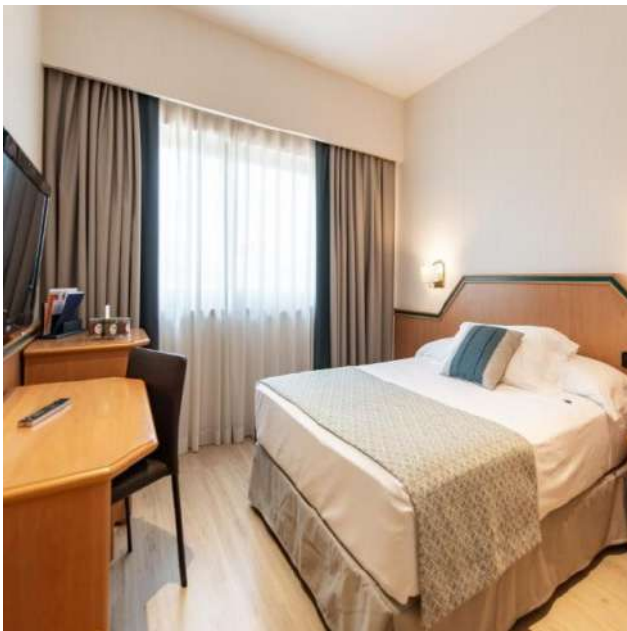
Sunday 25th April 2027
